UBC Geering Up Engineering Outreach is a student focused organization dedicated to promoting Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math (STEAM) concepts to the children and youth of British Columbia through fun, innovative, and hands-on experiments and projects. Geering Up recognizes that there are systemic barriers that prevent many people from pursuing careers in STEAM. Thus, Geering Up strives to reach all children and youth, regardless of gender, ethnicity, culture, or socio-economic status.

Over the past 30 years, Geering Up has reached over 150,000 youth through summer camps, in-school workshops, community outreach trips, clubs, and more. What skills are we looking for?

- Experience working with children/youth, preferably in a learning environment
- Background or comfort in STEAM, or a willingness to learn the basics of STEAM subjects
- Planning, organizational, multi-tasking, and self-directed work skills
- Proven leadership and people-coaching skills, ideally in a supervisory role
- Exceptional teamwork abilities
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Special consideration may be given to those who are able to drive and have a vehicle
- Experience purchasing and working within operating budgets
- Special consideration may be given to those with formal training in special education and/or disability theory, those who have worked in a programming environment in the past, and those with current Standard First Aid certification

What would you do in this role?

Integration Support Workers work 1-on-1 with children with exceptionalities and help them integrate into camps and have a safe, fun, and memorable camp experience. Under the guidance of the Coordinator, and Manager, Integration Support Workers are responsible to:

- Coach, support, and train an instructor team, enabling them to regularly perform at their best

- Develop and refine engaging STEAM curriculum for participants in-line with BC guidelines
- Act as an Instructor and role model at Geering Up programs Supervise, and provide guidance to volunteer personnel

- Follow safety and risk management policies to ensure safety and fun
- Complete all evaluations and reports in a timely manner
- Perform other duties, as requested by supervisors
